1. Scope

This policy applies to all directors, employees, contractors, suppliers and any other persons acting on behalf of Teek It Ltd.

2. Prevention Procedures

Teek It Ltd has implemented reasonable prevention procedures proportionate to the size and nature of the organisation. These include management oversight of financial activities, compliance with UK tax legislation, and the use of reputable professional advisers where appropriate.

3. Responsibilities

Overall responsibility for tax compliance and prevention of tax evasion rests with the Managing Director. All individuals acting on behalf of the company are required to act lawfully and ethically.

4. Reporting Concerns

Any concerns or suspicions relating to tax evasion or the facilitation of tax evasion must be reported immediately to the Managing Director. Concerns may also be raised under the Whistleblowing Policy.

5. Monitoring and Review

This policy is reviewed annually and updated where necessary to ensure ongoing compliance with legal requirements
